
Model: Problem Areas in Sensory Stimuli and Conflict in Communication Mediation

Visual Impairment

(due to light; restriction of visual perception in nonverbal communication; e.g. visual impairment, blindness)

Acoustic Disturbances

(through sound waves; e.g. loud background noise, distractions from parallel conversations, hearing impairments)

Skin-intensive Stimuli

Problem areas due to external and interpersonal stimuli

(e.g. due to very high or low temperatures; intense pressure and touch; acceleration/mechanical strain, e.g. during sports)

Chemical Stimuli

(e.g. through intense odors such as perfume and sweat; distracting sense of taste, e.g. through eating food)

Interpersonal Stimuli

(e.g. through spontaneous sympathy or antipathy towards other people; external, visual attractiveness in the eye of the beholder)

Lack of Congruence

(mismatch between verbal and non-verbal signals [speech, facial expressions and gestures])
